> What are Secure eServices?

The UJS Web Portal is also a gateway to information and functions for conducting court-related business. Secure eServices, also known as the Secure Web Portal, provides users the ability to access this information on any computer with Internet access. Court staff, District Attorneys office staff, probation officers, police officers, and attorneys depend on Secure eServices for Secure Docket Sheets, Secure Rule 509 Postings, Attorney Registration, GTS, PACFile, Statewide Warrants, Interpreter searches, Judicial Assignments, DA Link, and more, based on their security role. Access most Secure eServices functions can only be granted by contacting the county Clerk of Courts or District Court Administrator to complete the UJS Web Portal Secure Account Request Form. Those needing access to Attorney Registration, GTS, and PACFile need to create their own Secure Web Portal account. Review the help system pages on these functions for specific details.
